SPECIAL REGULATIONS

ARRIVAL: Cattle must be on the **Darwin Showgrounds, Winnellie - NO later than 2:30pm, Wednesday 21st July** and shall remain until after the Grand Parade on Saturday.

STUD SECTION: All stud cattle entRIES (Bulls, Cows and Heifers) for judging must be available to be weighed at 5:00pm Wednesday the 21st Of July.

FREIGHT: A freight subsidy of \$20.00 per head with a maximum of \$140.00 will be paid to all exhibitors of led stud cattle who have travelled more than 100km (To Claim Contact RASNT OFFICE). **Freight subsidy will only be paid on stock remaining until after the Grand Parade, Saturday.**

MOVEMENT: Exhibitors should ensure that any requirements for movement of stock are complied with. Stock returning interstate or below the tick line must be supervised with certification.

For information contact - Stock Inspectors Office, Berrimah Farm during normal business hours. Stock Inspector on 8999 2031 or 0401 112 031 or Regional Stock Inspector on 899 2030. All cattle nominated to attend the Darwin Show must be identified with a RFID before delivery to the showgrounds. The cattle must be accompanied by a completed waybill which includes the Property Identification (PIC) of the property of origin. The cattle steward will issue waybills for cattle leaving the showground. The Darwin Show Society will complete the upload of movement records to the NLIS database.

ALL CATTLE MUST HAVE NLIS TAGS

FOOD & WATER: To be provided by the exhibitor.

BEDDING: Will be provided by R.A.S.N.T. for Stud Cattle accommodation in pens.

STOCK: All stock animals to be accredited T.B. and Brucellosis free. All animals to be tick free.

All animals entered in Stud Section must be led and **MUST** be available for the Grand Parade.

Bulls: All Bulls over 12 Months of age must have nose rings inserted and be led.

Note:

1. No Bulls to be moved about the battle lanes unless properly restrained with nose holds.

2. Bulls under 12 Months of age must be restrained at all times by nose holds when being led in judging ring or moved around the cattle lanes

Females: All Females to be led with fitted nose clips at all times.

AGE: As at 28th June 2010

CAMPING: To advise number of campers & size of vehicle on entry form.

Armbands must be worn and will be issued from the cattle office.

Refer General Regulation No. 20 for Veterinary Services. General Regulations 1-38 also apply.
