LACEWORK

Lace is made in a number of ways and is delicate even if made with a coarser thread.

Lace is not always purely ornamental, it can be used for wearing apparel such as collars and cuffs, baby bonnets, bridal veils etc. Methods of Lace Making:

- With bobbins. With a needle - teneriffe, cutwork, drawn thread etc. With a shuttle - tatting.
With a hook - crochet. With 2 needles or a circular needle - knitted. With a hairpin - hairpin crochet.
