DELIVERY: Exhibits must be delivered to the Stewards, Agriculture Hall, Darwin Showgrounds **via Tate Place**. Between 8:00am and 7:00pm Wednesday 21st July. **Late entries may be accepted on delivery at the discretion of the Chief Steward.**

COLLECTION: Exhibits must be removed between 8:00am and 12:00noon on Sunday 25th July.

EXHIBITS: All produce to be fresh, grown in the N.T. and be the bona fide produce of the exhibitor.

Unless otherwise stated, all fruit & vegetables must be in a ripe/mature stage.

AKEE FRUIT for display or entry must be in a container with a clear lid or clear cling film cover.

The Chief Steward reserves the right to request property inspections prior to the Show.

Classes 54 - 58: Eggs must be in egg cartons. **Cartons to be plain not decorated.**

HIGHEST AGGREGATE must have minimum of 5 entries.

HONEY to be exhibited in CLEAR glass or CLEAR plastic containers. Min 200grams, Max 500 grams

General Regulations 1 - 38 also apply.

LABELLING: Where possible variety/type/common name of species to be on exhibit.

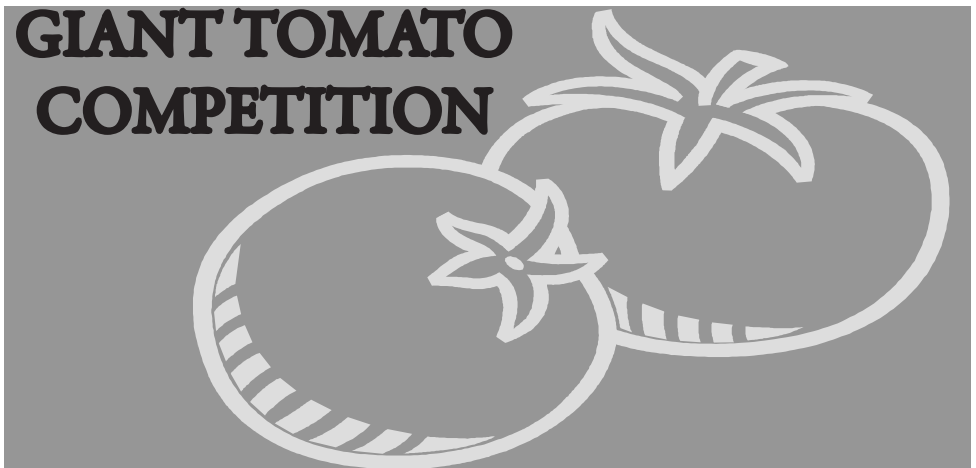
