SPECIAL REGULATIONS

PAVILION HOURS: Joe Yates Pavilion will OPEN at 9:00am and CLOSE at 8:00pm - Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

DELIVERY: All goats and sheep must be delivered to the Joe Yates Pavilion, Darwin Showgrounds, 1 Tate Place, Winnellie, between 9:00am and 7:00pm on Wednesday 21st July, and shall remain for the duration of the Show.

COLLECTION: All goats and sheep must be removed between 9:00am and 1:00pm on Sunday 25th July – No exceptions.

STOCK: Exhibitors should ensure that any stock movement requirements are complied with under the NT Livestock Act. For information contact Stock Inspector's DPI&R, Animal Biosecurity Office, Berrimah Farm during normal business hours. Stock Inspector on 8999 2034 or 0439 270 039 or the Regional Stock Inspector on 8999 2030 or 0401 115 802. All sheep and goats entered at the Royal Darwin Show must be identified with a National Livestock Identification System (NLIS) approved tag before delivery to the showgrounds. The goats and sheep must be accompanied by a completed NT Waybill which includes the Property Identification Code (PIC number). The Chief Steward will issue Waybill which includes the property identification (PIC) of the property. A show steward will issue waybills for sheep and goats leaving the showgrounds.

PENS: Exhibitors please nominate number of pens required.

FEEDING: Food and water is to be provided by the exhibitor. Exhibitors tending their animals will need to pay the gate entrance fee or become a Member of the Society.

WASHING: Goats must be washed prior to delivery. No washing is permitted after delivery.

DEFINITIONS: "Commercial" Goat bred for meat production.

REGULATIONS: Veterinary Services refer Regulation 21. General Regulations 1-38 also apply.

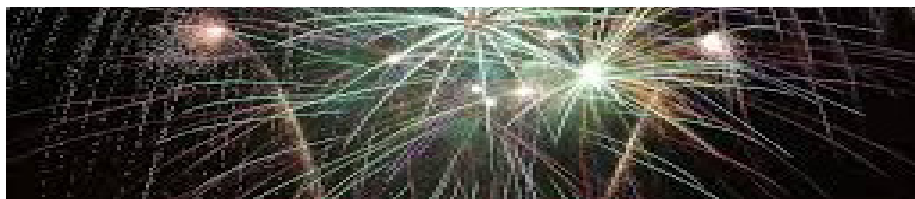
