SPECIAL REGULATIONS

DELIVERY: To be delivered to the Stewards, Horticultural/Agriculture Hall, Darwin Showgrounds via Tate Place, Wednesday 21st July, between 8:00am and 7:00pm.

ENTRIES: Entries will also be accepted for the following : Classes 1 - 49 on Wednesday 21st July between 8:00am to 7:00pm. Exhibitors must bring completed Entry Form/s. correct entry fees (cash) and exhibit/s to the Stewards in Horticultural Hall. Entries that win prize money can only collect prize monies from Monday 26th July between 9am to 2pm onwards..

COLLECTION: Exhibits must be removed Sunday 25th July, between 8.30am and 12.30pm.

DISPOSAL: Exhibits not collected within one week following the show may be disposed of at the Society's discretion.

EXHIBITS: All produce to be fresh, grown in the N.T. and be the bona fide produce of the exhibitor. Unless otherwise stated, for fruit/vegetables classes the same variety or type of fruit/vegetable must be entered. ie: if a Class states the quantity required is three, they are to be of the same variety not mixed. AKEE FRUIT for display or entry must be in a container with a clear lid or clear cling film cover. Chief Steward reserves the right to request property inspections prior to the Show. Classes 32-39: Eggs must be in egg cartons. Cartons to be plain not decorated. Eggs must come from the competitors own Chickens/ducks.
HIGHEST AGGREGATE must have minimum of five (5) entries.
HONEY to be exhibited in CLEAR glass or CLEAR plastic containers.
Exhibitors may enter multiple classes and enter multiple entries in the same class. General Regulations 1 - 37 also apply.

LABELLING: Where possible variety/type/common name of species to be on exhibit.

Class 1 COLLECTION OF FRESH HERBS AND SPICES, collection can be all herbs or mixture of herbs and spices, five or more used for cooking. Collection not to be in pots can be in displayed container(s) or other display method with no soil. All herbs/spices must be labelled. Points shall be awarded for arrangement as well as for quality and variety. 1st \$20; 2nd \$10. Sponsored by **Total Event Services.**

Class 2 COLLECTION OF FRESH HERBS, five or more used for cooking. Still to be growing in pot(s) can be in one pot or multiple pots. All plants to be labelled. Points shall be awarded for arrangement as well as for quality and variety.

- Class 3 COLLECTION OF MARKET GARDEN PRODUCE includes fruit and vegetables, herbs and spices. Points shall be awarded for arrangement as well as for quality and variety, Max. Size: 50cm x 50cm. Sponsored by **Total Event Services.**
- Class 4 ANY OTHER VARIETY VEGETABLE, any variety other than those named in other classes, three of the same type of vegetable and variety not mixed
